Invitation

The International Comet Assay Workshops (ICAWs) are a series of scientific conferences dealing with practical and theoretical aspects of the Comet Assay, aimed at both experienced and new users of this popular technique. The Workshop has always been rather informal. It began as a satellite to the 2nd International Conference on Environmental Mutagens in 1995. At that time, the Comet Assay community was small, and we mostly knew each other. Even now, following exponential growth in popularity of this assay, the workshop retains the feeling of an extended family, reunited every two years, with a healthy intake of new family members. We try to keep registration costs as low as possible to make it easier for less established researchers to attend.

The first five meetings in this series were called simply 'Comet Assay Workshops'. 'International' was added in 2005. At that time, the Comet Assay community was small, but in the meantime, has grown exponentially as did the popularity of this assay. All are equal, and the newest recruits can readily share ideas with the old-timers.

In 2020 former ICAW organisers, together with hCOMET COST-Action (CA15132) members, created the International Comet Assay Working Group (ICAWG). This group became an affiliated working group of the European Environmental Mutagenesis & Genomics Society (EEMGS) since 2020.

ICAWG exists to unit those scientists working in the field of genetic toxicology, DNA damage and DNA repair with interest in the comet assay (a.k.a. single cell gel electrophoresis). It encompasses research into the mode-of-action of genotoxic agents and associations of genome instability markers with disease outcomes, and applications of this knowledge in the field of regulatory toxicology, biomonitoring studies, (nutritional) interventions as well as clinical studies. A topic of growing interest is the genotoxic effects of nanomaterials on humans and the environment. Studies into the impact of genotoxic agents on genome stability in organisms other than man – a field known as ecogenotoxicology – is also gaining attention.

ICAWG aims to foster multi-disciplinary links between academics, industrial partners and regulatory bodies. Such multi-disciplinary collaborations have helped regulation to keep up with the science and to develop new *in vitro* models and techniques for genotoxicity testing.

Hence, the reason ICAWG organizes the International Comet Assay Workshops every 2 years. The 14th ICAW will be hosted by the Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology, from the University of Maastricht, from May 23rd until 26th 2022 at the Crown Plaza hotel. We are taking all possible measure to organize this meeting in a COVID-proof way.

We are crossing fingers that COVID situation will improve, so that we can welcome you to Maastricht in 2022.





Number and origin of participants


Participants to the 9th ICAW 2011 in Turkey (total number of participants; N=140)



Participants to the 10th ICAW 2013 in Portugal (total number of participants; N=102)




Participants to the 11th ICAW 2015 in Belgium, (total number of participants; N=104)






Participants to the 12th ICAW 2017 in Spain (total number of participants; N=105)

A sponsorship contract will be concluded with the sponsorship prospectus by the Conference coordination team on behalf of the Organizing Committee. All sponsors will be treated equally on a 'first come, first served' basis.

The contract must be countersigned and returned within two weeks from the day of proposal in order to be valid for the ICAW2022 event.

Sponsors are not allowed to stage their own events parallel to the conference events without consulting the Conference Secretariat.

Terms of payment

In case the Sponsor cannot pay the full amount in one go, the following terms of payment apply:

- 30 % of the contracted amount at contract signing;
- 70 % of the contracted amount before April 30th 2022.

Refund and cancellation for sponsorship contracts

The items are refundable minus a 10% charge when the cancellation is made within one month of the order and before the 31st of January 2022.

For items cancelled after the 31st of January 2022 and before 1st of March 2022, 50% of the total amount value of the order will be refunded.

For items cancelled after the 1st of March 2022, there will be no refund granted.

If the items have been sourced from external suppliers and a contract signed, the costs incurred plus the corresponding charge (based on the above dates) will be charged to the sponsor. All prices are indicated in EUR and exclude VAT.

All cancellations must be made in writing to the Congress coordination team.

Cancellation due to COVID-19
