PROVISIONS CONCERNING ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

- 1. Responsible animal husbandry in the housing association are permitted by the Board's written consent. Consent may be refused if the board finds reason for doing so.
- 2. All animals must be registered with name, species, race, age and when the animal is acquired.
- 3. There is no more than one pet per apartment allowed. The board may dispense with this.
- 4. Certificate of completion of training courses, vaccination certificates against distemper and worms, must be presented when the board requires. The worm cure must be reviewed twice a year.

 Required vaccination certificate for other animal species must likewise be submitted to the board upon request. Cats should be sterilized / castrated and a certificate for this shall be submitted to the Board for approval given. The Board may grant exemptions from this.
- 5: Leash for animals is mandatory within the association area.
- 6. If the animal leaves excrement on the association's territory, the owner is responsible for removing this.
- 7. Animal keeping must not be a nuisance to neighbors, or suffice these disadvantages.
- 8. If the Board finds it necessary, it may be required to remove the animal immediately and no later than the deadline set by the Board. Violation of these provisions will be considered as violation of the house rules and rental agreement and may result in termination of the rental with 1-month notice
