Sacrament of Confirmation: Unfortunately, the Government updated their public health advice on the 14th May, stating: "It is advised that other religious ceremonies such as First Holy Communions and Confirmations should not take place in May and June. Further advice will follow on resumption of these ceremonies when it is safe to do so". This is very disappointing for the children and their families who were looking forward to receiving their Confirmation in June. New provisional dates for Confirmation will be set when the Government deems it safe to proceed.

Triduum in honour of Our Lady. The second of the Triduum of Masses will be celebrated on Tuesday, the 25th of May in Bawnboy and the third Mass will be celebrated in Kilnavart on the 31st of May. Each evening will begin with Mass at 8pm and conclude with the Rosary and Benediction. It will be broadcast on FM108 and streamed on the parish Facebook page for those who cannot attend.
