Bottle's containing holy water from St Mogue's Font will be available for collection on the day. People will also have the option of celebrating the pattern as a community after the 8pm Mass.

Feast of St Mogue: Suggested Pattern:

Pray before the Blessed Sacrament and say one Our Father, one Hail Mary, and one Glory Be as well as the Apostles' Creed for the Pope's intentions.

Make the Stations of the Cross. (A suggested text will be available at the door).

After you have completed the Stations, proceed to the St Mogue's Holy Water

Font. Kneel or stand in front of it for a few moments while you recite prayers of your own choice. The Novena Prayer can be said at this time.

That completes the Station.
